1. OVERVIEW

Prefectural University of Hiroshima, PUH, is going to launch a NEW program, “Discover Hiroshima” !

This is a one-week program designed to deepen understanding of Japanese culture and Hiroshima. In addition to briefly experiencing various research fields at our university, participants will have the opportunity to interact with our students and enjoy Hiroshima, including visits to the two world heritage sites of Miyajima and the Peace Memorial Park.

All activities are conducted in English.

*This program does not offer credits.

3. NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS

Capacity: **20 students**

If the number of applicants exceeds the capacity, the participants will be determined by selection. In order to maintain the diversity of participants, the number of participants from one university may be limited. Please understand that there may be cases in which you will not be able to participate in the program. The result will be announced after the application deadline.

If the minimum number of participants is not reached, the program may be cancelled.

4. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Applicants need to meet both of the following conditions.

- (A) Undergraduate students belonging to universities outside of Japan. (PUH partner universities only)
- (B) English language proficiency at a daily conversational level or higher (No other language support provided.)

* Faculty and staff are not eligible to participate.

5. PROGRAM FEE

-**60,000yen** (However, students from partner universities in Indonesia, Vietnam, Malaysia, Thailand, and Bangladesh* will be charged **30,000 yen**.)

*Japan's ODA recipients at present

-The Program Fee includes accommodation fee for 8 nights (August 19 to 27), insurance fee for August 19 to 27, bus and train fares during the program, admission fee to facilities visited during the program.

-Travelling costs to Hiroshima, living costs (communication and food expenses), visa fees and other expenses must be paid by the participants.

- Each participant is responsible for arranging his/her own airline tickets and transportation to and from the hotel. PUH will not make arrangements on your behalf under any circumstances.

6. NOMINATION (DEADLINE : MAY 31, 2024)

7. APPLICATION (DEADLINE : JUNE 10, 2024)

Please apply in the following two steps.

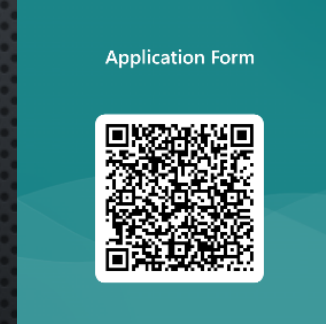

〈Required Documents to be submitted〉

- 1 Transcripts showing the total GPA of the applicant's home university
- 2 Photocopy of the ID page of the applicant's passport

8. PAYMENT

- After the application deadline, the Acceptance Letter will be sent to your registered e-mail address from PUH.
- After that, please transfer the participation fee by **July 31st**. Please pay through Flywire to the name of Eikei University, which is run by the same corporation as that runs PUH. You can find the name on the list on the website.

Please note that you should enter 20140820 in the field asking for “student number”.

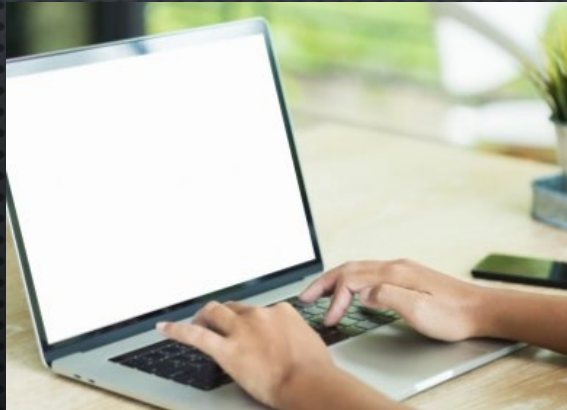

11. INSURANCE

All participants must have insurance coverage as specified by PUH. The period of coverage is the duration of the program, and the insurance premiums are paid by PUH. If a participant arrives in Japan earlier or stays longer than the insurance period, he/she may need to purchase additional insurance for the extra period by himself/herself.

<Coverage and Conditions>

- Injury Death : JPY2,000,000
- Sickness Death : JPY1,000,000
- Specific Severe Disability Compensation : JPY1,000,000
- Injury and Sickness Medical Expenses* : JPY800,000

* If the insured person pays medical expenses of JPY 10,000 or more for a hospital visit or hospitalization due to a new illness or injury that occurs during the policy period, the amount paid will be covered up to JPY 800 000 for a period of 180 days from the date of the first visit.

<Note>

- Insurance does not cover accidents during travel to/from Japan.
- Pre-existing medical conditions are not covered by insurance.
- The insurance taken out by PUH for you is minimal so you can take out additional insurance on your own if necessary.
- **Insurance details may change at a later date.**

12. VISA

Applicants may need a 'short term visitor visa' to enter Japan, depending on their nationality. Please check the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan website to see if you need to apply for a visa.

If you need to obtain a visa, please choose "Visa is required" when you submit your application on the application website. After you are accepted to the program, please make the payment as soon as possible in order to proceed with your visa application without delay.

After we confirm your payment, you will receive additional instructions from our office on the visa application.

*Regarding the flight information, if you have not finalized in detail, please fill in the flight you are most likely to choose.

Necessary documents for your visa application below will be provided. (Please note that the required documents vary depending on your country of residence. Please refer to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan website for details.)

- (2) Letter of Invitation
- (3) Travel Itinerary
- (4) PUH brochure
- (5) Letter of Guarantee
- (6) Certificate of Employment of PUH's Faculty

Visit your local Japanese Embassy/Consulate General with the above supporting documents to apply and obtain a visa. We suggest you to contact them in advance to check if any additional items or documents are required for your application.
