# NTUNHS Introduction



## The Mainstay of Taiwan's Healthcare System

National Taipei University of Nursing and Health Sciences (NTUNHS) was founded with nursing at its core and has lead vocational education in nursing in Taiwan for more than 70 years. NTUNHS has gradually developed into an academic institute consisting of 3 colleges (the College of Nursing, the College of Health Technology, and the College of Human Development and Health), 12 departments, 12 graduate schools, and an educational center. NTUNHS strives to become a high-quality university of science and technology that aims to improve public health and welfare by providing education in outstanding health care and management.

### Educational Goals

National Taipei University of Nursing and Health Sciences goal of NTUNHS is to cultivate outstanding health care and management professionals. All graduates shall have five core capabilities, including:

1. Health Service (Professional Competence)
2. Human Compassion (General Capacity)
3. International Perspective (Professional Competence)
4. Technological Application (Professional Competence)
5. Lifelong learning (General Capacity)

### Faculty Members and Students

NTUNHS has a comprehensive teaching system and is the first choice for students looking to obtain in-depth training from a healthcare vocational school. Our system includes a four-year Bachelor's program, a two-year Bachelor's program, a Continuing Education Program, Master's and PhD programs, and a total of about 5,000 students. NTUNHS employed about 190 full-time faculty, including over 80% associate and professors. Our faculty members are experts in perspective fields and also have extensive experience in practical teaching. In addition, NTUNHS has an incentive program for teacher training and academic research, and encourages teachers to continue professional sophisticated academic and practical experience.


### Campus Environment

NTUNHS has two campuses covering a total of 8.1 hectares. The sub-campus is located on Neijiang street within Taipei City, while the main campus is located on Minde Rd in the Beitou District, located near the Taipei Veterans General Hospital and Cheng Hsin General Hospital and therefore well connected with various medical education systems. The campus perfectly interconnects with surrounding business districts in a fully functional community that constitutes a diverse living and learning environment.

To meet the students' needs, NTUNHS has made efforts to create a campus which is friendly, kind, safe, as well as adaptive to its students. For these needs, we have recently built a Fitness Center, a Tea House, a Grief Healing Garden, Indigenous Resource Center. In addition we have designed a themed Garden that signifies birth, aging, and sickness as well as an emergency alert system that enhances campus safety. Our campus provides our students with a high-quality and safe environment that is well suited to cultivate healthy and optimistic professionals. The Two New Buildings of the Main Campus: The Teach and Research Building and third Students Dormitory began construction in March 2019 and are slated for completion in 2021. Students from the Downtown Campus will be relocated back to the Main Campus to ensure students can happily learn at an unhurried pace in a high-quality and safe environment, allowing students to care for both their mental and physical health as they become optimistic and proactive professionals.




# Program Structure

It's a **3-year** Program and the course structure consists of two parts, the **Chinese Preparatory Course** as well as the **Bachelor Degree Program**.

In the first year, students must take **Chinese Preparatory Course** in advance, Ministry of Education and NTUNHS will cover the tuition in this period. Students are eligible to enter the Bachelor of Long-Term Care Program only if they **pass TOCFL A2 level**.

Students are also **required to pass TOCFL B1 level during the 2nd academic** year and could apply for the NTUNHS scholarships under this circumstance.



# Department of Long-Term Care

The institute trains students to become practitioners, operators, policymakers, and policy enforcers. It prepares relevant teaching and research talent for long-term care and cultivates the following skills:

- (1) Consolidate long-term care related basic, professional, and advanced knowledge, and provide professional services, teaching and study.
- (2) Enhance students' self-learning and research skills.
- (3) Supervise and manage long-term care cases and organizations.
- (4) Emphasize the importance of both theoretical and practical models of education.
- (5) Plan and promote long-term care related policies and laws, and systems.



## Program Features & Career Outcomes

Long term care is a fast-growing profession in Taiwan, in this program, students will study Mandarin in the first year and learn both theoretical knowledge as well as practical technique for the upcoming two years. During their school years, students could find part-time work by their own since Chinese Preparatory Course or have the paid -internship at healthcare institutions which recommend by school after finishing the first semester of Long-Term Care Program.

After fulfilling all the conditions prescribed, students are eligible to work in the field of long term care in Taiwan legally. NTUNHS will also provide job matching service to facilitate finding the most appropriate job position for international students. Students who graduate from this program will not only have professional expertise but also equip with at least intermediate Mandarin skills, which makes them bilingual advantage to develop better career opportunities in Taiwan compared with peers.

	<b>Autobiography Study Plan</b>	Please submit an Autobiography as well as the study plan written in Chinese or English.
	<b>Financial statement</b>	Financial proof that shows financial sustainability for studying in Taiwan (document of financial support with a minimum balance of USD 4,000 or TWD 100,000), or proof of full scholarship provided by a government agency, university.

## Admission Results Announced

- After the admissions posted, NTUNHS will notify admitted students and issue acceptance letters by both e-mail and post. The acceptance letter or admission notice does not guarantee that a visa will be issued. Visas are approved and issued by the Taiwanese overseas embassy or consulate.
- At the time of registration, admitted students should present proof of insurance, including both medical and personal accident coverage for a period of at least six months from the date of their arrival in Taiwan. If insurance is provided by a company in another country, proof of insurance should be verified by a Taiwanese overseas embassy or consulate.
- Admitted students shall be present at NTUNHS for pre-registration on the designated date specified on the admission letter. Applicants who fail to complete these procedures on time will be regarded as having forfeited their eligibility.

### **(1) Chinese Preparatory Course Scholarship:**

MOE and NTUNHS cover full tuition fee for the Chinese Preparatory Course.

### **(2) Bachelor Degree Program Scholarship:**

NTUNHS Scholarship : 100 % tuition fee waiver  
50 % tuition fee waiver

NTUNHS Support Fund : NTD 5,000 /per month  
(8 months for 1 year)

### **(3) Industry Scholarship:**

This scholarship is from NTUNHS collaborated health-care industries and will provide living allowances (2 years) to limited quota students with excellent academic performance.
